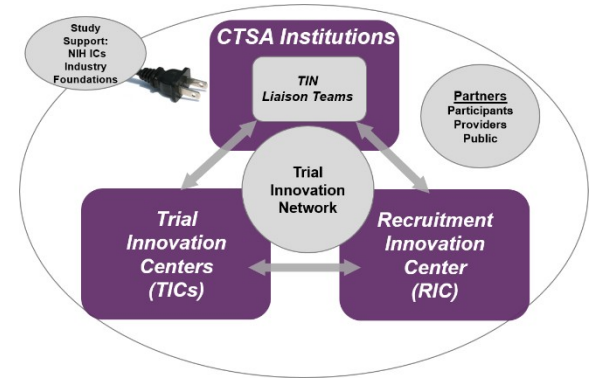




What is the Trial Innovation Network?

The Trial Innovation Network (TIN) is a collaborative initiative within the CTSA Program and is composed of three key partners – the CTSA Program Hub Institutions, the Trial Innovation Centers (TICs), and the Recruitment Innovation Center (RIC).

The goal of the TIN is to serve as a national laboratory to study, understand and innovate the multi-site clinical trial process. Implementing advances in this process will result in improved and more cost-efficient trials.
